Back to Trieste in 2004, he became project manager for HAL/P&O/Cunard ships, role he has covered up to 2006 when he assumed the responsibility of Engineering & Design for both Merchant and Cruise ships Business units integrating them by 2007.

Within the Corporate, in 2010 he became Deputy Chief Operating Officer and Executive responsible for Engineering. In 2011 he ad interim also became executive responsible for industrial system; role he accomplished in 2013 when he has been in charge with manufacturing & design Integration in Merchant Ships Business Unit also maintaining both the role of Deputy chief Operating Officer and the role of Executive responsible for Engineering, role kept up to 2015.

In March 2016 he is named Executive Vice President of New Building, up to August 2018 when he is appointed Director of Merchant Ships Business Unit.
