In addition, Fincantieri and WSense are actively involved in the participation in additional Italian and European tenders aimed at innovation in the underwater sector, as well as in joint commercial proposals.

The investment in WSense, a cutting-edge Italian center of excellence in the development of innovative solutions for wireless networks and underwater monitoring and surveillance systems, is a further building block in the Fincantieri Underwater strategy. It strengthens its position in critical technologies for underwater communication, which is a sector of growing relevance, especially in the context of dual-use applications.

With this transaction, we are confirming our commitment to investing in pioneering solutions that can define the future of shipbuilding and underwater defense, while simultaneously supporting the growth of an Italian center of excellence and reinforcing Fincantieri's leading role in our country's industrial landscape."
